

LOWER SIXTH BUSINESS ENTERPRISE 2009-2010

The Lower Sixth students of each House are required to form a **company to raise funds for a charitable cause**. 50% of the profits raised by the activities of the company are donated to the charity chosen by the House and 50% may be retained to benefit the House. In addition, each House team is required to make a presentation to the whole Lower Sixth, giving details of their activities and reporting on their success (or failure!) over the period of the project. This presentation is judged by the Headmaster and Bursar. The Phillott Bowl is awarded to the winning team.
